MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE SALDEN CHASE SUB COMMITTEE HELD ON THURSDAY 8TH SEPTEMBER 2016 IN THE COUNCIL OFFICES, 221 WHADDON WAY, WEST BLETCHLEY

1. Apologies for Absence

Apologies were received from Cllr Pallett and the Clerk of Bletchley & Fenny Stratford Town Council.

2. Declarations of Interest

3. Minutes of last meeting

The minutes of the meeting held on 16th February 2015 were approved as a correct record of the meeting.

4. Terms of Reference

Resolved: that the revised Terms of Reference for this Sub Committee, as approved by Full Council at its meeting held on 15th August 2016, be noted.

5. Submission of formal revisions to the planning application

Resolved: that the submission of formal revisions to the planning application ref: 15/00314/AOP to Aylesbury Vale District Council and planning application refs: 15/00223/CONS & 15/00619/FUL to Milton Keynes Council be noted.

The Clerk advised that comments regarding application 15/00314/AOP should be made to Aylesbury Vale District Council by 22nd September 2016 either directly using the facility on the planning application webpage, by e-mail to devcon@aylesburydc.gov.uk or by post to Planning Department, Aylesbury Vale District Council, Gatehouse Road, Aylesbury, Bucks, HP19 8FF.

Comments should be made to Milton Keynes Council regarding application 15/00223/CONS by 12th September 2016 and regarding application 15/00619/FUL by 28th September 2016 although MKC's officers had advised that they would continue to receive comments past that date. Comments to MKC should be made either directly using the facility on the planning application webpage, by e-mail to businesssupportreports@milton-keynes.gov.uk or by post to Planning Department, Milton Keynes Council, Civic Offices, 1 Saxon Gate East, Central Milton Keynes, MK9 3EJ.

Any agreed extensions to these deadlines would be published on West Bletchley Council's website.

It was further noted that Newton Longville Parish Council would be holding a Public Meeting on 20th September 2016 which would be attended by representatives of the SWMK Consortium. Further information would be published on West Bletchley Council's website.

The Clerk also reported that Milton Keynes Council officers had advised that the earliest time when the Council would formally consider these applications would be at its Development Control meeting on 3rd November 2016.

7. Actions taken in respect of the application

The Clerk advised that the following actions had been taken in respect of the applications:

- Information about the revisions to the applications and arrangements for comment, had been published on WBC's website and shared using facebook and twitter.
- Updates had been sent to residents' e-mailing lists.
- West Bletchley Council had engaged a planning consultant to provide professional advice and support in composing its response to the application.
- West Bletchley Council were liaising with Newton Longville Parish Council with a view to engaging a traffic consultant to carry out a review of the traffic aspects of the revisions.
- Liaison had taken place with adjacent parish councils with regard to co-ordinating actions and responses in respect of the application.

- Forwarding any new information and objection letters to WBC for circulation to other members of the Sub Committee.
